




#### **CASH SEIZURES**

#### Fewer seizures yielded more cash seized







#### Primary drug of choice for clients being assessed for treatment



#### Primary drug of choice for reception inmates



#### TCU Drug Screen V results for all BARC's clients assessed



## PUBLIC SAFETY: IMPAIRED DRIVING


#### DUI stops:

more males than females provided samples as they were more likely stopped



#### DUI class participation over the past 10 years






#### **CAUSES OF DEATH**

## DEMAND & SUPPLY REDUCTION SPENDING


#### Drug control expenditure in 2024 vs. 2023


