THE MALE SILENT CRISIS



Men are less likely to seek help

Men account for ~70–80% of individuals who never reach out until crisis.



Men experience higher risk behaviors

Men are 2–3x more likely to use substances to cope with stress.



Male distress impacts families

Unaddressed male emotional issues increase conflict, withdrawal, and instability at home.

Why Males? Why MASC?

- Men are less likely to seek help until crisis.
- Untreated male distress contributes to family conflict, violence, substance use, and community instability.
- Men often carry burdens silently.
- Boys are more likely to act out instead of open up.
- Boys often show earlier behavioral signs but receive later intervention.


