The Child Development Programme (CDP) and Early Childhood Assessment Team (ECAT)

The Team

ECAT is multidisciplinary team comprising of Psychologists, Speech and Language Pathologists and Occupational Therapists. This is a collaborative service provided by the Department of Education and Department of Health through the Child Development Programme.

Who and what do they assess?

At this time the Team assesses children from 18 months to 4 years 11 months to determine if they meet criteria for diagnoses in the DSM-V such as Autism Spectrum Disorder. The assessment will determine motor and language strengths and weaknesses.

How do I refer?

Paediatricians and parents can make a referral to ECAT. If you are concerned that your child may be on the spectrum you can contact CDP at 295-0746.

***It is recommended that children have a hearing and vision screening before the assessment**
