Q1. We hereby request clarification as to the packaging of the freight as detailed on page 2 or the RFQ. "Freight: c.10,000lbs weapons and ancillaries".

Please revert with details on the above-mentioned freight. Will it be Pelican cased, boxed or palletized, and what are the maximum dimensions of the largest item to be placed in the cargo hold? Any fragile items such as antennae?

The payload/range/ cargo hold dimensions will affect our choice of aircraft and is therefore an important data point for our pricing.

R1. The detail you require is below. As it transpires the weight is a lot lower than originally thought.

1 Box containing 15 x Rifles = 185 lbs x 4 box = **740 lbs** Weapon Boxes 42 x 23 x 18 (L x W x H)

1 Box containing 10 x Rifles = 130 lbs x 1 box = **130 lbs** Weapon Boxes 42 x 23 x 18 (L x W x H)

1 Box containing 35 x Blank Firing Attachment = 63 lbs x 2 boxes = **126 lbs** (Medium 31 x 23 x 16)

1 Box containing 280 x magazines = 150 lbs x 1 box = **150 lbs** (Medium 31 x 23 x 16)

1 Spare box & Accessories = **50 lbs**. (Small 23 x 15 x 15)

Total: 1196 lbs (9 x boxes)
