Application for Permit to Import Insects

An import permit issued by the Department of Environmental Protection and an invoice from the exporting country, must accompany all shipments of beneficial insects/nematodes arriving in Bermuda. Imports arriving without this documentation will be confiscated and destroyed.

- All insect/nematode shipments must be delivered **directly** to the Department of Environmental Protection for inspection. Consignee must be the Department of Environmental Protection.

- Shipments must contain **only** the species identified on this permit.
- All insects/nematodes must be shipped free from all plant material, live insect/nematode hosts or prey.
