## Pending Mold Decontamination Process and Temporary Procedures to Follow

- 1. This Circular follows Circular 21 and 22 of 2016.
- 2. No requests should be made for cause book or judgment searches prior to Monday 31 October 2016. A further notice will follow once the cause books and judgment books have been decontaminated and deemed mold-free.
- 3. No search praecipes for access to Court records should be filed prior to 4 November 2016 as Registry staff does not currently have access to court records. A further notice will follow once the Court records have been decontaminated and deemed mold-free.
- 4. While the new temporary location of the Registry in the Dame Lois Browne Evans Building on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor will be open to the public for filing purposes, members of the Bar are requested to restrict all filings to urgent matters in so far as is practicable.
- 5. All Court of Appeal filings for the November 2016 session should be filed at the Government Administration Building on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor where the Commercial Courts are located. Members of the Bar are asked to contact the Court of Appeal Administrator, Joyce Waddell, <a href="mailto:jdwaddell@gov.bm">jdwaddell@gov.bm</a> in advance of all Court of Appeal filings.

6. The continued understanding and patience of members of the Bermuda Bar Association and the general public will be required.
