



## PROCUREMENT NOTICE

This Procurement Notice is issued by the Government of Bermuda (the “Government”) to provide summary information in relation to a specific procurement, as detailed below.

### 1. Subject Matter of Procurement

RFP Title: **Installation of Two Overhead Refuse Cranes and Associated Equipment**

RFP Number: **2023-003-TB**

Purchase Type: **Construction**

The Government of Bermuda’s Tynes Bay Waste-to-Energy Facility would like to enter into an agreement with a suitably qualified Contractor to install two (2) overhead refuse cranes in the Tynes Bay Waste-to-Energy facility.

The Government have purchased two (2) new 6000 kg overhead refuse cranes with 17.5-meter spans and all the associated equipment and control systems to replace two (2) similar overhead refuse cranes located above the refuse bin near the Tipping Hall and originally installed in 1992.

The Proponent shall facilitate the safe removal of two (2) existing 17.5m x 6000 kg overhead refuse cranes as well as all of their associated equipment and the complete installation of two (2) new 17.5m x 6000 kg overhead refuse cranes and all their associated equipment.

#### **8. Site Visit / Pre-Bid Meeting Details**

The above location will be the initial meeting point then the tour will move as follows: Control Room, MCC room, Tipping Hall, Refuse Bin area, 6 m level, any other area as requested.

The site visit will be conducted in order to become familiar with conditions that may affect the proposed work.

All proponents or their official representative(s) attending the site meetings are responsible for their own cost and it is required that they to attend each area of the site, so they are fully acquainted with existing conditions and limitations.
