

Primary 1 Screening

What is it?

- There are 3 components to P1 screening: Speech and Language (S&L), Occupational Therapy (OT) and Physical Therapy (PT).
- Each area will assess the student's abilities to make sure that he or she is age appropriate. In the event that a student does not pass the screening, another appointment will be made for the student to be fully assessed.

Who gets screened?

- All students entering public primary school in September 2023, who have not been previously identified, will need to be screened.

When is the screening?

- July 3rd — 14th, 2023

Where will the screening take place?

- All screenings take place at Victor Scott Primary School, Glebe Road Pembroke.

How does the screening work?

- Parents will be contacted to set up an appointment with therapists. The screenings can last between 20-60 minutes depending on how many screenings. Example: a student may need to be screened for Speech and Language only, or he/she may need to be screened for S&L, OT, and PT.
